I well remember our Bicentennial in 1976. I had just finished my freshman year in college. Red, white and blue were seen everywhere. I had a pair of sneakers in those colors (don't laugh – they were really cool, or at least I thought). There were the usual parades, fireworks and celebrations – but all at a heightened level.

Chaney writes, “Can you stand up next to Lee Greenwood and sing, ‘I’m proud to be an American’? Pride may not be the right word.
